- Home visiting is required
- Free preschool program funded by the State of Michigan

## HEAD START

- Program for three and four year olds
- Children of all abilities may participate
- Lead teacher has a Master's Degree in Early Childhood Education
- Program is four days a week, three and a half hours a day
- AM and PM classes are available
- Meals and snacks are provided for all students
- Free preschool program funded by the federal government

## EARLY CHILDHOOD SPECIAL EDUCATION

Services are available to support children ages birth to five who are developing slowly in one or more areas. Instruction takes place in a setting with typically developing peers whenever possible.

### Areas of Development Include:

- Social skills (handling emotions and interacting with others)
- Gross and fine motor (use of small and large muscles)
- Cognitive (thinking and reasoning)
- Adaptive (self-help skills)
- Language (receptive: understanding and expressive: speaking)
